

Currently, all foods and beverages sold to students at school before or during the school day are required to meet the **Smart Snack Nutrition Standards**. The Smart Snacks in School regulation applies to foods and beverages sold a la carte, in the school store, vending machines, and any other venues where items are sold to students.

The Alliance for a Healthier Generation developed a Smart Snacks Calculator that can be used to determine if foods and beverages are compliant.
